Employment was frequently irregular. There were few skilled laborers as shown by the following table: The average wage of the Mexican worker was \$10.35 per week; the Italians \$12.35, and the others \$13.60. In the Mexican family the average number of children per family was three; in the Italian family, three; and among the others there were two children per family. When we consider the size of the family and the wages, we are appalled at the small sum on which these people exist. Occasionally roomers or boarders were secured to help supplement the family income, but with large families and small houses this procedure was not always possible or desirable.
