Most celebrated is The Canterville Ghost, an engaging, comical tale centering around the ghost of Sir Simon de Canterville, who for some 300 years had terrorized the residents and employees of Canterville Chase. When the manor is bought by the Otises, an American family that refuses to believe in such supernatural nonsense, hilarious results ensue. Three other stories include The Sphinx Without a Secret, a tale of an enigmatic woman who carries the key to a mystery with her to the grave; The Model Millionaire, a charming story of a delightful, ineffectual young man with a perfect profile and no profession ; and Lord Arthur Savile s Crime. Rounding out the volume are Wilde s lyrical Poems in Prose The Artist, The Doer of Good, The Disciple, The Master, The House of Judgment, and The Teacher of Wisdom.
