Specifically, GAO discusses Interior s progress in achieving the following four outcomes: (1) maintaining the health of federally managed land, water, and renewable resources; (2) ensuring visitors satisfaction with the availability, accessibility, diversity, and quality of national parks; (3) meeting the federal government s responsibility to preserve and protect Indian trust lands and resources; and (4) ensuring the safe and environmentally sound development of mineral resources. GAO could not judge the agency s progress in promoting the health of federally managed land, water, and renewable resources because the goals Interior has reported do not foster a broad or departmentwide approach to measuring progress. Although the Park Service s strategies for continuing to meet and exceed its visitor satisfaction and visitor education goals appear clear and reasonable, the agency s fiscal year 2002 performance plan lacks information on the strategic human capital management strategies to achieve this outcome.
